1 Curriculum and Assessment Matters

a. Weighted Assessment 2 (Secondary 1 & 3)

Please note that <u>13 May 2022 (Friday)</u> is <u>Home-based Learning (HBL) Day</u> and your child/ward need not report to school. The subjects allocated for this day would be shared by the Form Teachers 1 week prior to the start of the HBL day. The timetable and general topics/tasks that students would be engaged in would be uploaded on our school website under '**Academic Matters**'.

b. Mid-Year Examination (Secondary 2 & 4/5)

The Secondary 2 and Secondary 4/5 cohorts will be commencing their Mid-Year Examination (MYE) from Thursday 05 May to Thursday 12 May 2022. We believe that our students will utilise this opportunity to assess their own learning and to reach out to the teachers or other resources to enhance their learning if need be. 



c. Mother Tongue Intensive (Secondary 4/5 students)

Travel Declaration 3.




