

4E/5N English Listening Comprehension Preliminary Examination


Your child/ward will be taking his/her English Listening Comprehension Preliminary Examination on **05 Aug 19 (Mon)** from 3 pm to 4 pm.

Please be informed that any absence from the examination must be supported by a medical certificate. Otherwise, your child/ward will be awarded zero for the paper he/she missed. Students who are absent with valid reason (e.g. medical certificate) will have their SA marks reflected as Valid Reason (VR). There will be no re-sitting for any papers. Students who are late for the examination will not be given any additional time.

ASSESSMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Students must be in the assessment room ten minutes before the start of each paper. Students who report later than 15 minutes after the start of a paper will only be allowed to take the assessment with the approval of the Principal or the Key Personnel in charge of the assessment. No additional time will be given to latecomers.
- Staff Well-Being
- Students must be <u>properly attired</u> in school uniform and follow school rules as usual.



- 3. Absolute silence must be observed at all times in the Assessment venue.
- 4. Students are to be seated according to their class register numbers. Students may change their seats only with the permission of the invigilator.
- 5. All bags, books, files and any other reference materials are to be left in the front of the assessment room. Students found in possession of any books, telecommunication devices or any unauthorized electronic devices or notes on or in their desks shall be considered to have retained them for the purpose of cheating and will face serious disciplinary action.


6. Students are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to use transparent pencil case. Any students who are not using transparent pencil case have to place their stationeries on their

Students are not allowed to use correction tape/fluid during assessment.






9. Only writing paper, drawing paper and graph paper provided by the invigilator may be used in the assessment.
